Devon has around 39 resident **butterfly species** and we can help point you in the right direction regarding where and when is best to see them.



Work at **Shaldon Wildlife Trust** is vital to the long-term survival of many animals which are

at risk of extinction in their natural habitat. None of our animals have been taken from the wild; the majority were born in our zoo or come from other collections taking part in specific breeding programmes to ensure their survival.



British Waterfowl Association is a charity focusing on waterfowl; dedicated to education about them, their conservation, and raising the standards of keeping and breeding ducks, geese and swans in captivity.



The Woodside Animal Welfare Trust is an animal rehoming charity as well as a large and vital safety net for vulnerable animals. The sponsorship of a dog kennel, cat pod or rabbit pen helps to support the animals short term in our homing blocks.



The Barn Owl Trust is a small national charity working very hard to conserve one of the most beautiful birds on Earth. Anyone who has ever watched a wild Barn Owl hunting at dusk has surely been touched by the experience.



Hedgehogs are in serious decline and are now officially vulnerable to extinction. **Prickles in a Pickle** is a home-based Wildlife Sanctuary which has become busier and busier over the years, especially with sick hedgehogs. The hedgehog rescue & wildlife sanctuary is located in south Dartmouth, Devon.

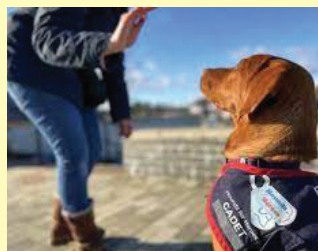

Yealmpton Show

Public Safety Notice

The organisers of the Yealmpton Show have made considerable efforts to ensure that your visit to the Show is as enjoyable & safe as possible. To assist us, though, we do ask you to do the following:-

1. Be alert to your surroundings.
2. Take care of your children by keeping them close to you and under your direct supervision.
3. Keep push chairs away from large animals as they may react to them.
4. If you lose your child, go to the Secretary's tent. If you find a child, stay where you are and send a message to the Secretary's tent.
5. Park your car as directed by the stewards and take care when walking to and from the showground through the car park. When reversing your car, do so carefully. The speed limit on the Show Ground at all times is 5 mph
6. Make yourself aware of the location of the First Aid point, next to the Secretary's tent.
7. Always keep your dogs on a lead and away from the livestock.
8. The Show takes place in fields so the ground may be uneven or slippery in wet conditions.
9. Be aware that there are guy ropes and pegs around marquees and tents so avoid coming into contact with them.
10. Drink plenty of water if the weather is hot and use sunscreen or sunblock. Take regular rests.
11. Listen to public announcements and advice from the Stewards. Follow any instructions that are given.
12. Please put your litter in the bins.
13. Stay well away from moving machinery and vehicles and do not tamper with them. Stay behind barriers or ropes when watching demonstrations and horse events.
14. Do not walk in the Animal Collecting Rings or the Show Rings.
15. Remember that all animals and birds can be unpredictable so treat them with care.
16. Wash your hands thoroughly before eating if you have been handling animals.
17. When entering marquees, take note of safety notices and exit signs.
18. Follow the safety advice when using the fairground rides.
19. Do not smoke in any of the marquees or tents.
20. Drink alcohol sensibly. Anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated and offenders may be removed from the Showground.
21. In an event of an emergency, please contact the nearest Steward who will deal with the problem.
22. If you hear a fire alarm/bell sounding, evacuate the area/marquee/tent and await instructions from a Steward or via the Public Address system.
23. Horses and ponies may only be ridden in the designated areas and not in areas open to the public.

Following prolonged dry weather, the grass may be more susceptible to fire.
Please take extra care with cigarettes, matches and barbecues.

Notice to Exhibitors & Competitors

Exhibitors, traders and competitors must comply with the relevant Health and Safety regulations as well as the conditions of entry to the Show for traders and exhibitors.

HEALTH & SAFETY FOR ALL COMPETITORS, EXHIBITORS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC

The organisers of the Yealmpton Agricultural Show will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, every-one present must themselves take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards. The organisers of the Show hereby give notice that they will accept no liability for injury to the person or any animal or for any loss or damage whatsoever suffered by any competitor or exhibitor in any horse-jumping or livestock competition or event. All such competitors and exhibitors take part at their own risk and before entering should inspect the course to satisfy themselves that the condition of the ground and construction of the fences are safe for competition.

EMERGENCIES

In the event of a major incident stewards report to the secretary's tent and liaise with the Director of the Yard and Safety Officer, or as directed by the P.A. system.

In an emergency, please contact the nearest show official who will address the problem.

In the event of a fire in a large marquee, a fire alarm (bell or horn) will warn occupants. The secretary must be informed immediately as well as the emergency services of any fire. (The emergency entrance for fire / ambulance is through the main entrance at Kitley Lodge gate and should be met at the lodge gate by a designated person to direct them to the incident.)

A FIRST AID POINT is adjacent to the Secretary's tent.

IN THE EVENT THAT EVACUATION OF THE SHOW GROUND IS NECESSARY
FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN AT THE TIME EITHER FROM THE P.A. SYSTEM OR BY A
STEWARD.

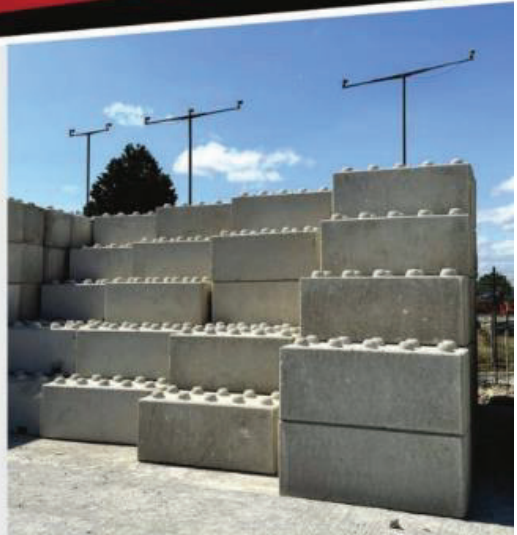

The objective is a long term one to create a wildlife corridor within the River Yealm catchment from its source on Dartmoor to the estuary at Wembury by connecting up and re-storing and joining fragmented habitats.

We are lucky to have great primary schools keen to be involved in nature-based activities. The primary schools are involved in the **Catchment Schools Art Challenge final**. Paintings from Yealmpton, Newton Ferrers, Wembury, Brixton, Sparkwell, and Cornwood schools, together with Yealmpton Preschool and Venture Outdoors Kindergarten, will be on exhibition with much of the children's work on display in the YEM stand at the Yealmpton Show. This year's challenge- **Where the river meets the sea-** will be judged at 11am by Gina Bastard, Lydia Milford, and Judith Mears. at the Yealm Estuary to Moor YEM stand opposite the Landrovers.
